Beginning May 31, 2016, Lawrence Academy will host a variety of programs for children in grades Pre-K – 12 and adults. The camps will feature local instructors covering a wide array of topics including; Arts, The Culinary Arts, Driving, Parents and Grandparents Science and Nature, and Sports.

Program costs start at \$25 and range from 1 – 4 days, depending upon the camp chosen, and some offer discounts. The dates and times of the camps vary, but programs are scheduled weekly from May 31st through July 31st, excluding the week of July 4th. Unless otherwise stated, the programs will be held on the campus of Lawrence Academy, however some camps include field trips, and few are off-campus.

Driver's Education:

Students 14½+

Driver's education is the first step in the graduated licensing process for North Carolina teenagers. The North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) requires **all teens** younger than 18 years old to complete Driver's Ed before they can apply for their NC learner's permit. Driver's Ed will help you get your learner's permit, and eventually your driver's license, by teaching you how to drive safely and responsibly.

To enroll you must:

- Be at least 14 1/2 years old.
- Have your birth certificate or a valid passport.
- Currently be enrolled in high school and on your way to earning your high school diploma or its equivalent.

Driver's education consists of:

30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction. During the classroom instruction, you will learn information about driving regulations, violations, and safe driving. Once you've completed the in-classroom component of Driver's Ed, you will be able to get behind the wheel where you will learn and practice important driving skills under supervision and get a feel for what it's really like to drive a car. After successfully completing behind-the-wheel instruction, you'll be done with North Carolina Driver's Ed and will receive your Driver Education Certificate.

SECTION 5: PERMISSIONS AND WAIVERS

FIELD TRIP PERMISSION:

Parent or Guardian must provide transportation to and from the field trip, and must remain with the camper unless other arrangements are agreed upon beforehand. If parents are not able to attend, permission must be granted by parent or guardian for camper to travel with another adult, and signature must be provided along with the name of the adult accompanying the child. Programs that are off-campus are considered representatives of Summer Escape/Lawrence Academy and must follow the same guidelines of behavior and indemnity.

RELEASE & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT:

I understand that there are risks involved with any program that may include but are not limited to equipment problems or failures, inclement weather, actions of other participants, and physical injuries. Despite these risks, I choose for myself and/or child to participate. With my signature, I acknowledge all risks of injury, illness and loss of life, and I agree to assume all responsibility pertaining to the participation in these programs. Also, I confirm that they are no medical or other reasons that my child should not be involved in these programs. I agree that my child and I will follow all rules and regulations of the programs and respect the instructors of said programs. I return for the opportunity to be involved in these programs, I agree to waive and discharge any legal right to seek payment of any kind from Summer Escape/Lawrence Academy, its employees, guest instructors, or representatives for injury, illness, or loss of life resulting from the programs. In registering a child for these programs, I attest that I am a parent, legal guardian, or am otherwise responsible for the child whose application I am submitting and that I waive and discharge any legal right that I may assert on behalf of the child participating in the program. I also agree not to prosecute Summer Escape/Lawrence Academy, its employees, guest instructors, or representatives and agree to reimburse Lawrence Academy for all claims, damages, losses, or expenses, including attorney's fees, if suit is filed due to injury, illness, or loss of life resulting from participation in the programs.

I, the undersigned parent or guardians, realize that an emergency situation may arise where the delay of medical attention may jeopardize the well-being of my child. I grant permission to the staff of Lawrence Academy summer programs or its agents to make judgment in my absence concerning medical or hospital care in the event of such an emergency. I understand that Summer Escape/Lawrence Academy will not administer any medical medication unless a medication release form has been provided.

I HAVE READ ALL INFORMATION ON THIS REGISTRATION FORM AND AGREE, ON BEHALF OF MY CHILD AND MYSELF THAT I UNDERSTAND AND WILL ABIDE BY ALL POLICIES. I AGREE TO INFORM MY CHILD OF ALL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS WHILE ATTENDING LAWRENCE ACADEMY SUMMER PROGRAMS. I ALSO ACKNOWLEDGE THAT ALL INFORMATION IS CORRECT AND THAT MY CHILD IS PHYSICALLY AND EMOTIONALLY CAPABLE OF POSITIVELY PARTICIPATING IN SPECIFIED CAMP ACTIVITIES. SECTION 6: PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

SUMMER PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

1. Campers are expected to abide by the behavior expectations.
2. Except when excused by the Summer Programs Director, all campers are expected to remain on campus with the program in which they are enrolled.
3. All campers should come dressed in appropriate attire for the type of camp he/she is attending. Specifically, campers participating in sports camps should dress appropriately and bring proper equipment. Also, campers should wear appropriate footwear. Campers participating in sports camps should wear closed-toe tennis shoes or cleats.
4. Lawrence Academy prohibits the use and distribution of all tobacco products by employees, students, and visitors.
5. Campers are not permitted to possess or use alcoholic beverages or illegal substances on or off campus. The possession of weapons or explosives of any kind, or objects, tools, or devices that may be used as weapons are prohibited on campus and at any summer program-related activity unless used specifically for the program as described in the syllabus.
6. Campers should abide by the rules of their instructor and show respect at all times.

CAMPER ADVERSE BEHAVIOR CONSEQUENCES:

One of the primary objectives of the Summer Escape staff is to provide a positive and safe environment that allows your child to have a fun and enriching camp experience. In order to provide such experience, Summer Escape asks that all staff members use praise and positive reinforcement as an effective way of managing the behavior of each camper.

Should a negative behavior issue arise, we will apply the following guidelines:

1. **FIRST OFFENSE:** A quiet, verbal warning.
2. **SECOND WARNING:** Verbal warning to camper and a phone call to parent or guardian
3. **THIRD OFFENSE:** Written incident report will be given to the parent or guardian. If the unsuitable behavior continues beyond the written warning, the camper will be asked to leave for the remainder of the camp with no refund of fees.

PAYMENT AND REGISTRATION FORMS:

All payments for camp registrations are to be made in full at the time of registration and should be made to each instructor.

SECTION 7: REFUND POLICY

All Summer Escape programs require a minimum enrollment; **you will be notified at least one week prior to the start date in the event a program must be cancelled.**

Program fees are fully refundable when the program is cancelled by Summer Escape. Otherwise, program fees are refundable as follows:

1. Cancellations received at least one week prior to the start date of a program are entitled to a refund minus a 10% cancellation fee.
2. There will be no refunds if a cancellation takes place **after** a program starts if a camper is suspended from a program due to failure to follow program guidelines.
3. Hardship or medical situations will be addressed on an individual basis and to the discretion of the Summer Escape Director.
