Driver's Education:

Students 14½+

Driver's education is the first step in the graduated licensing process for North Carolina teenagers. The North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) requires **all teens** younger than 18 years old to complete Driver's Ed before they can apply for their NC learner's permit. Driver's Ed will help you get your learner's permit, and eventually your driver's license, by teaching you how to drive safely and responsibly.

To enroll you must:

- Be at least 14 1/2 years old.
- Have your birth certificate or a valid passport.
- Currently be enrolled in high school and on your way to earning your high school diploma or its equivalent.

Driver's education consists of:

30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction. During the classroom instruction, you will learn information about driving regulations, violations, and safe driving. Once you've completed the in-classroom component of Driver's Ed, you will be able to get behind the wheel where you will learn and practice important driving skills under supervision and get a feel for what it's really like to drive a car. After successfully completing behind-the-wheel instruction, you'll be done with North Carolina Driver's Ed and will receive your Driver Education Certificate.

In this 3 part camp, students will spend their time learning the proper care and use of a fishing rod, different casting techniques, fishing safety when fishing near others, and how to carefully remove a fish from a hook in order to let it go. Our fishing times will include afternoon as well as morning times so that we can cover all of the different styles of fishing.

The first day of camp will be spent at LA working on those skills. Students will try their hand at lots of different casting techniques, and practice being safe around others. We will also play a few games centered around fishing.

The second day we will be fishing at Scotch Hall in their ponds. We will meet at Scotch Hall. This will be a MORNING time as we want to see the difference in morning and afternoon fishing. Students should be there by 8:30am and be picked up by 11:00am.

The third and final day will be at Bayside Marina in Edenton. Students should plan to meet at Bayside at 2:00pm. We will fish until 4:00pm as a group. We will be fishing from the boardwalk that extends from the marina to the bridge.

What students should bring:

- Rod and reel
- Any tackle they want to use (live bait and some artificial bait will be available for them to use)
- Snack and drink (each day)

Each student will take home a "goody bag" of custom painted lures and hand poured plastic baits from Firehouse Customs, JR Custom Lures, and Kneedeep Tackle.
